

Script for the GSARC Business Net

This is the Script and necessary procedural steps required to run the *GSARC Business Net*.

Access the 145.43, 145.29, 147.22 or 147.38 repeater about 3 minutes prior to the Net and say . . .

1) This is **"Your Call Sign"** standby for the **Golden Spike Amateur Radio Club Business Net** in ***** Minutes**.

At 8:00 PM, begin the Net by saying . . .

2) This is **"Your Call Sign"**. Good evening and welcome to the **GSARC Business Net**. This Net is sponsored by the **Golden Spike Amateur Radio Club**. This Net is scheduled each Wednesday evening at 8:00 PM using the 145.43 and the 448.30 Mhz repeaters on Blue Spring Hills both having a PL Tone of 123. This Net is also linked to the 145.29 Mhz repeater in Brigham City the 147.22 Mhz repeater above Fielding-Riverside and the 147.38 Mhz repeater atop Dunn Peak all having a PL Tone of 123.

3) Net Control for this evening is **"Your Call Sign"**, my name is **"Your Name"** and I'm located in **"Your Location"**. This is a directed Net. Stations without emergency traffic should not transmit until asked to do so by Net Control. Emergency traffic will be taken at any time during the Net.

(Optional - - - Read first Wednesday of the month)

4) In the event of a real emergency, tune to this, or any other repeater in your local area to help with emergency communication needs. If the repeater is not functioning, locate the nearest operating repeater, or tune in to your local ARES Simplex Frequency.

Local Emergency ARES Simplex Frequency's are as follows:

Box Elder County 146.48

Cache County 147.52

Davis County 147.42

Morgan County 147.50

Salt Lake County 147.54

Tooele County 145.73

Utah County 146.46

Weber County 146.58

(* Simplex Frequencies verified: Dec-2018)

5) All Licensed Amateur Radio Operators are invited to check-in to this Net. Announcements and Traffic will be conducted at the end of the roll call. Please indicate any traffic as you check-in.

6) Are there any stations with emergency or priority traffic?

Handle this traffic before moving on.

7) Are there any emergency powered or mobile stations to check-in to the Net?

Acknowledge all check-ins. For check-ins not on the roll ask for their first name and location

8) Roll call will begin now.

Acknowledge all check-ins. Enter those who check-in with an 'X' and those with traffic with a 'T'.

At the end of the roster say . . .

9) That's the end of the roll as I have it. Are there any late, missed or new check-ins?"

Acknowledge all check-ins. For check-ins not on the roll ask for their first name and location.

10) Are there any more late, missed or new check-ins?

Repeat as needed.

Conduct any traffic in the order it was received on the roll.

11) "This concludes the *GSARC Business Net* for **Wednesday (today's date)**. Thank you for your participation. The repeaters will now be returned for normal use. This is **"Your Call Sign"** clear.
